In 2009, most services of the Burk's Falls & District Health Centre (including urgent care) were shut down. Although assurances had been provided as recently as 2006 that this facility was required to serve the needs of the Almaguin Highlands, budget cutbacks at the Muskoka Algonquin Healthcare (Burk's Falls' affiliate at the time) forced its closure.

When we're at the cottage, timely access to quality healthcare isn't necessarily top of mind. But what happens if someone in our family, or

a guest, has a sudden need for medical attention? Perhaps a cut or a broken bone or an allergic reaction. From Three Mile Lake, that would mean at least a 35minute trip to Huntsville or a one-hour trip to North Bay, plus potentially hours in a waiting room once there. And for full-time residents of the Almaguin Highlands, who may live in more remote locations. the minimum travel time is likely more than one hour.

Some Things To Consider When You Return to the Cottage ...

If you've been away from the cottage for a while, there's always a chance of unexpected surprises when you arrive. Here are some things to watch for...

Animal Intrusions ... inspect for obvious damage and animal calling-cards (droppings and other messes)...call an animal control company if something bigger than a mouse has moved in.

Human Intrusions ... do NOT enter if access appears recent or if you suspect someone is there - call 911. For obvious nonemergency, call O.P.P. at 705-382-2015.

Winter/Storm Damage ... check for obvious damage from trees/wind...check for moisture or rotting damage (replace rotted siding, re-finish areas showing signs of deterioration, replace broken or cracked windows, etc).

Roof Damage ... check for missing / damaged shingles, loose flashing around chimneys and vents, check inside for leaks.

Water and Drainage ... check property for standing water...could be a drainage, runoff or plumbing issue.
