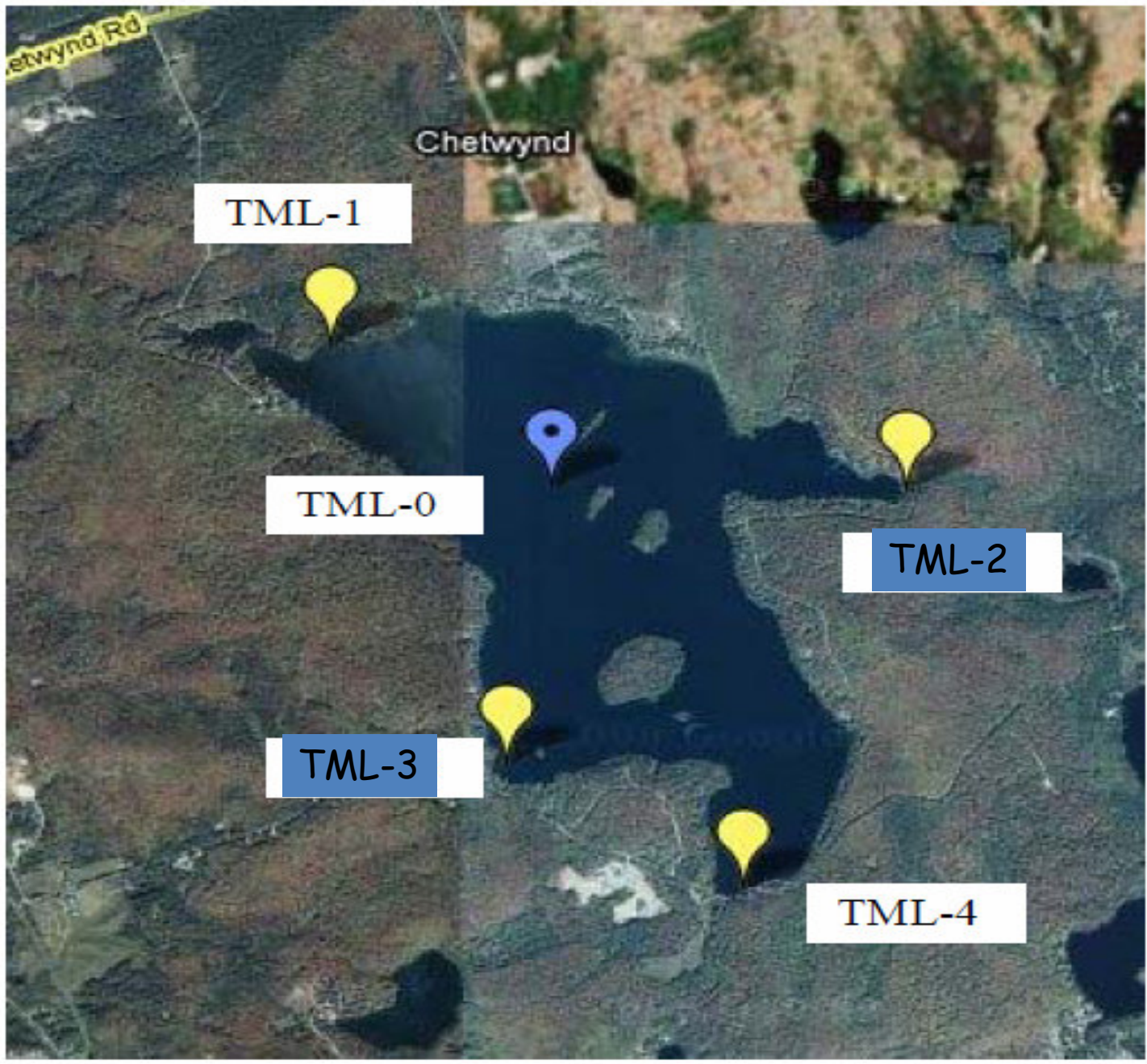

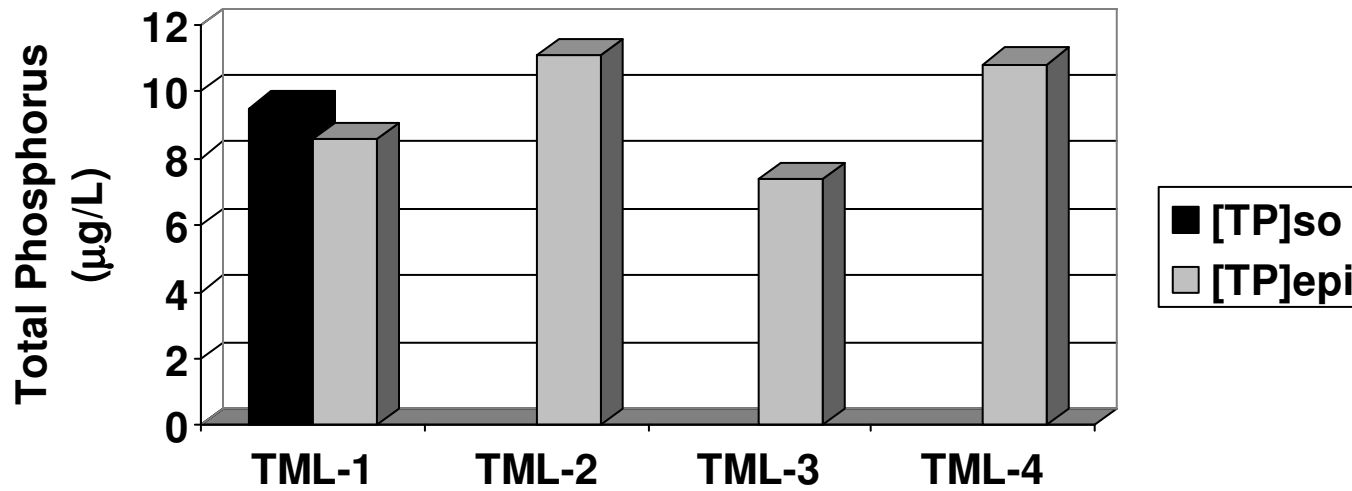

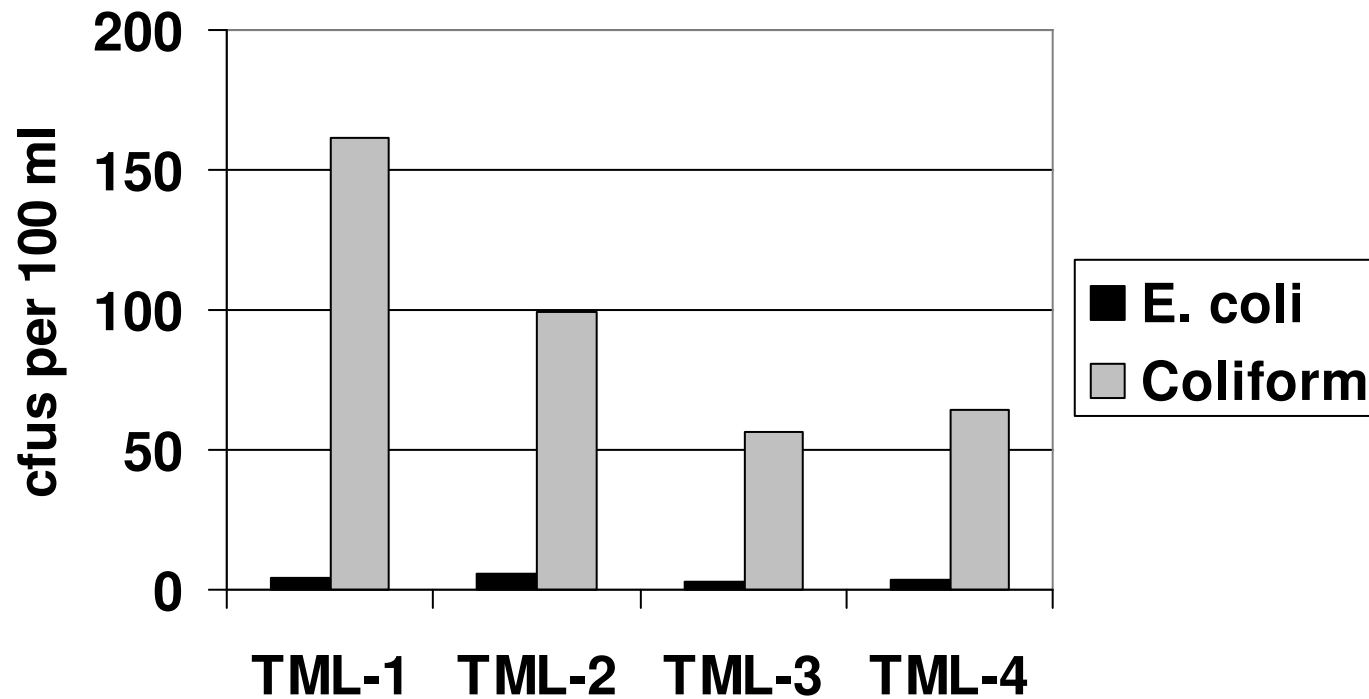
# Phosphorus Readings - 2008

## E. Coli and Coliform Readings - 2008

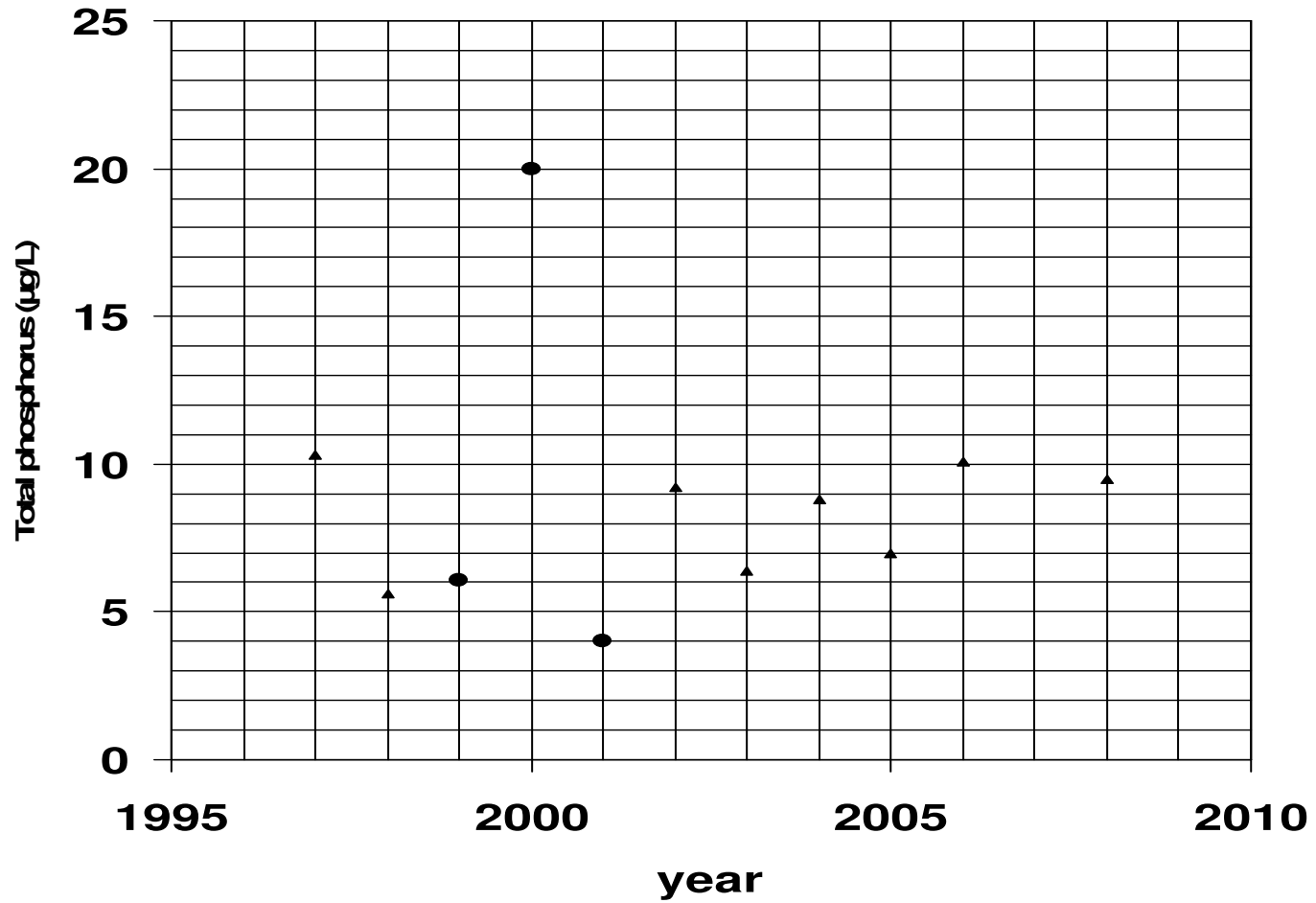
### 2008 Results for TML-Katrine *E. coli* and coliform



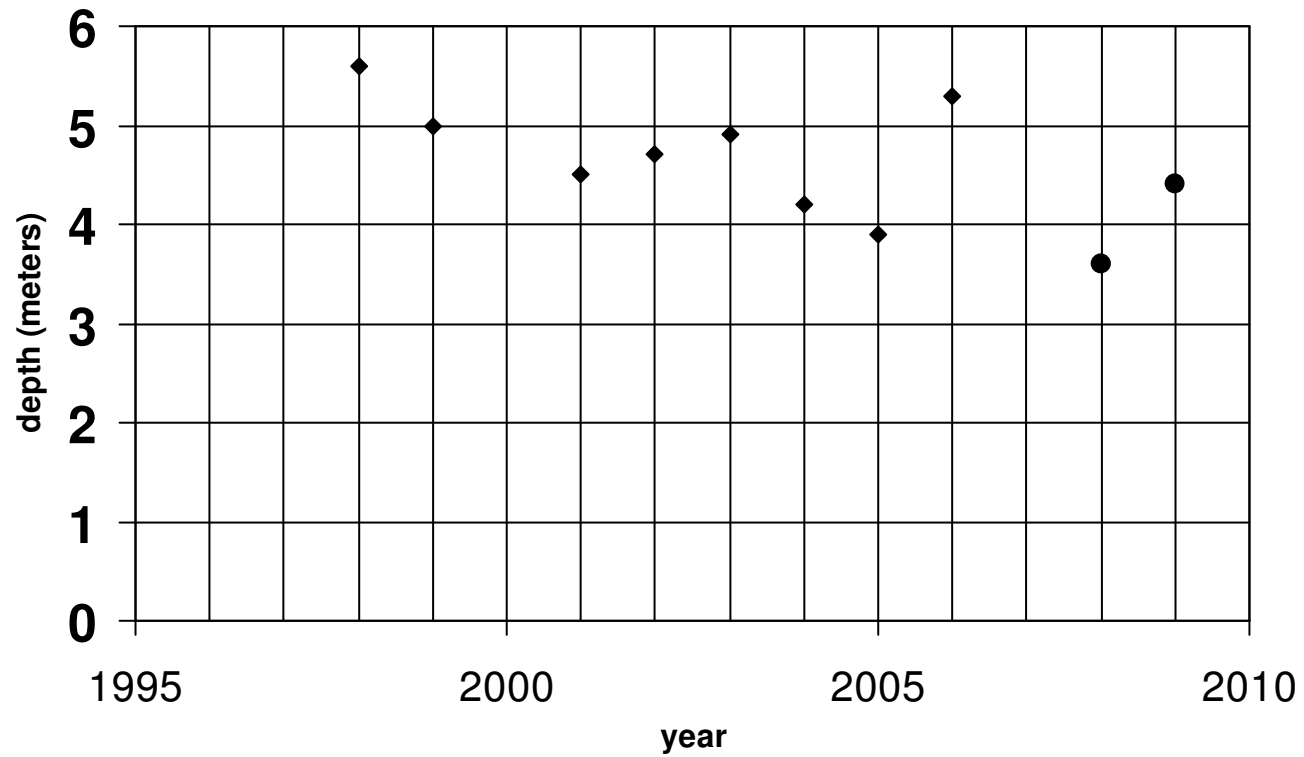


# Historical Average Phosphorus in TML-Katrine

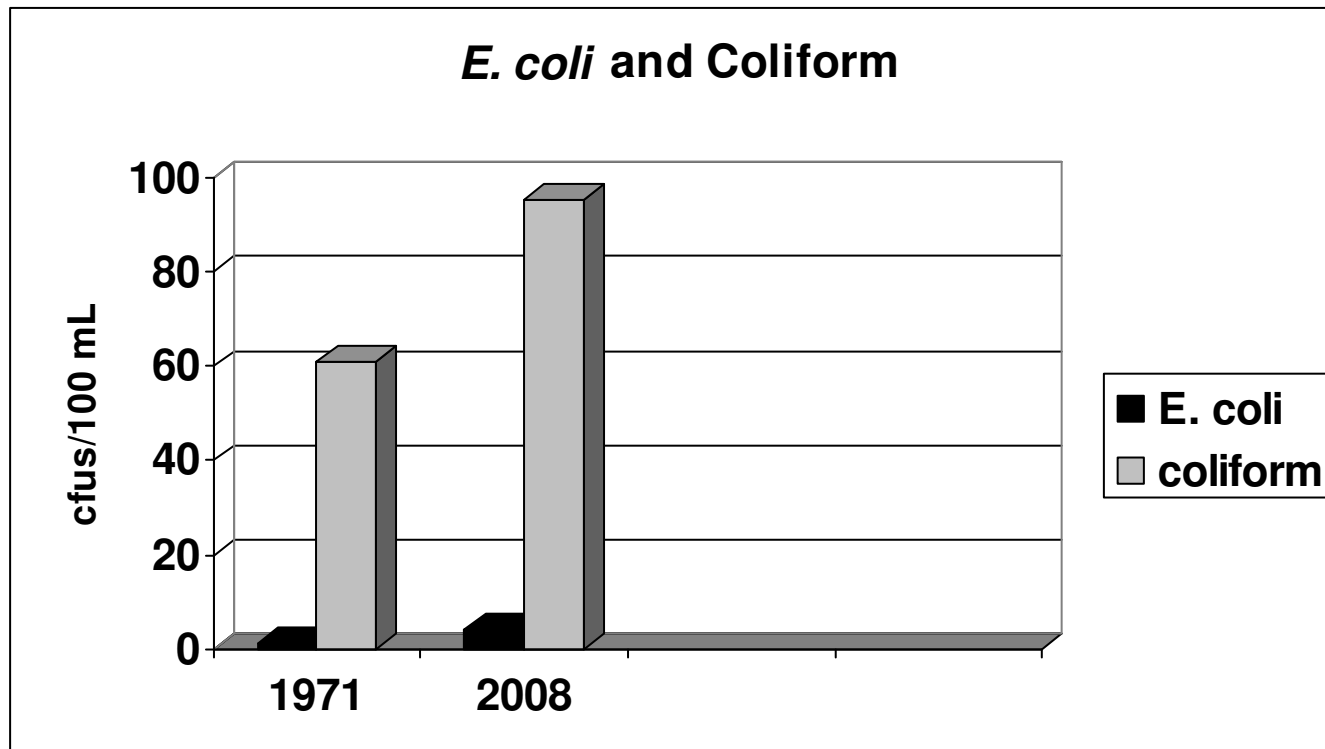
(Ontario Water Quality Objective is 10 $\mu$ g/L)



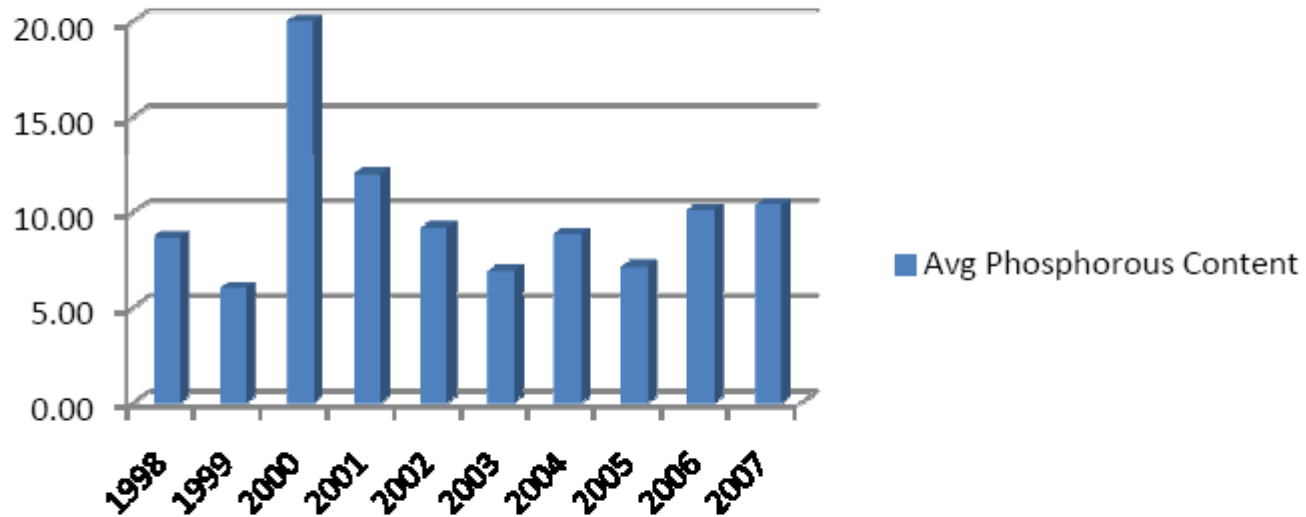
## Historical Water Clarity in TML-Katrine Average Annual Secchi Depths in Meters
