

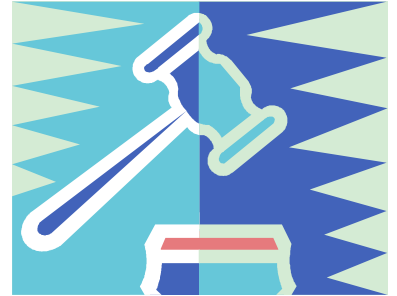

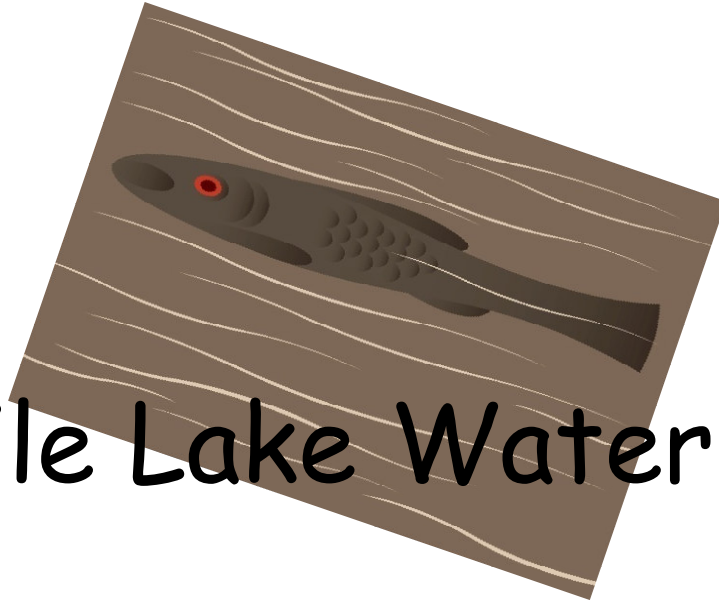

- Team Lead and team of volunteers collecting and 'incubating'.



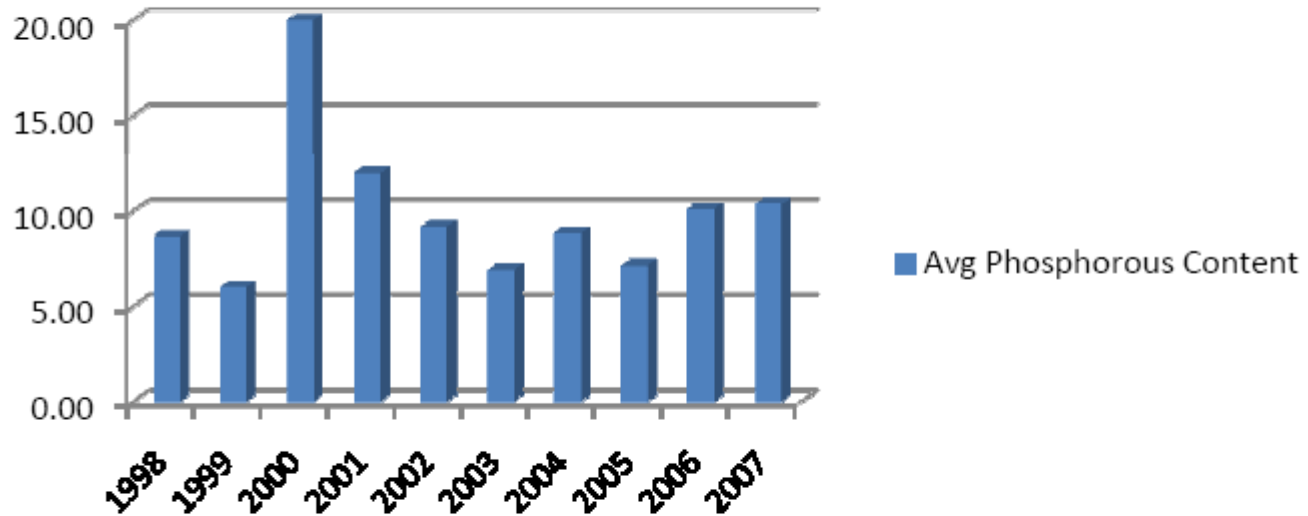
Three Mile Lake Water Quality

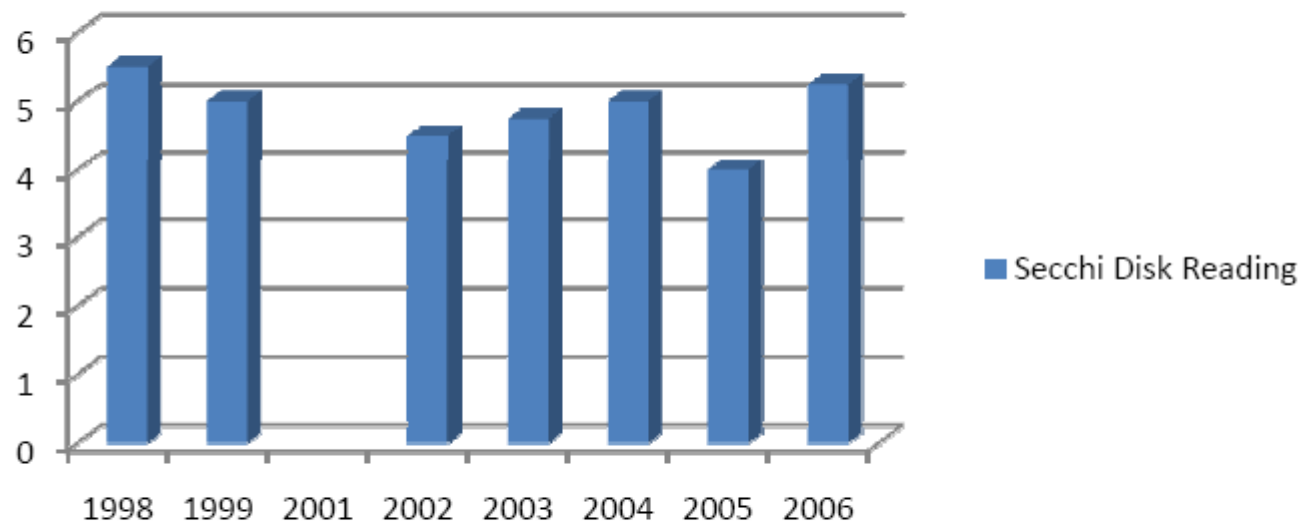

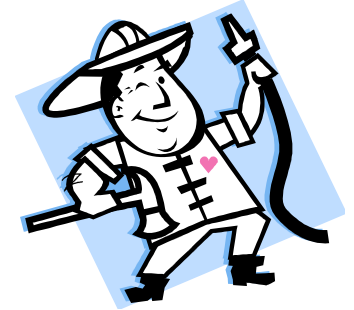

Cottage Fire Safety Tips...

- ✓ Install smoke alarms on every storey and outside all sleeping areas...
- ✓ Test smoke alarms monthly...keep a spare and change batteries regularly
- ✓ Ensure carbon monoxide alarms installed and functioning...
- ✓ Develop and practice a cottage fire escape plan...
- ✓ Know your cottage 9-1-1 address ...
- ✓ Know the phone number for the local fire department - **9-1-1 for emergencies** ...
- ✓ Clean barbecues before use ... don't leave bbq's unattended ...
- ✓ Check heating appliances and chimneys before use ...
- ✓ Check with local fire department or municipality to determine rules for open-air fires
- ✓ If you must smoke, do it outside...keep a large can of water nearby...
- ✓ Burn candles in sturdy candleholders that will not tip...when you go out, blow out!

Local and Regional Updates (cont)...

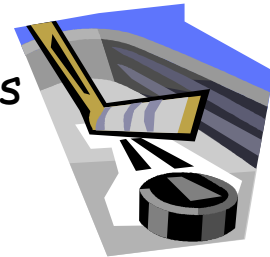
Miles for Coins - Burk's Falls and District Health Centre

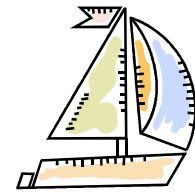
- Sunday, August 3
