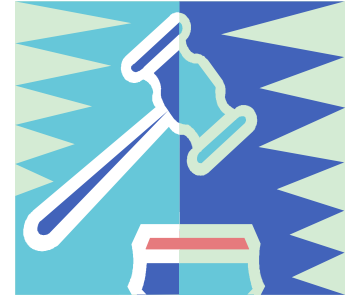

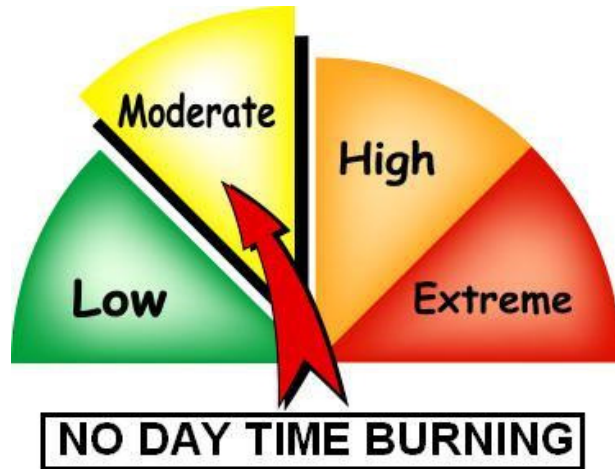

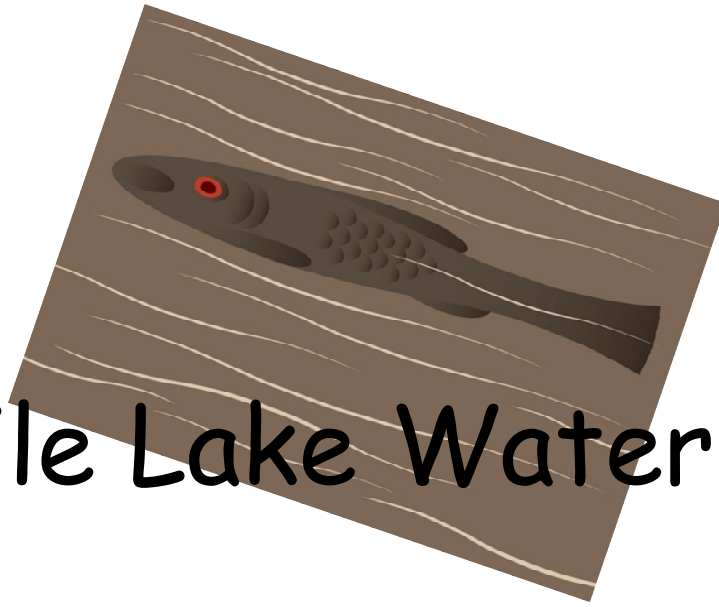
Today's Fire Rating...

Take care when burning outside...remember to monitor the current fire ratings...remember that in Extreme conditions, things like fireworks are banned...

# Fire Rating Explanations

Low	Daytime open air burning allowed Nov 1 to March 31. Camp Fires allowed.
Moderate	Daytime open air burning allowed Nov 1 to March 31. Camp Fires allowed.
High	NO OPEN BURNING. Camp Fires for cooking and warmth only.
Extreme	No OPEN BURNING. Camp Fires NOT allowed. Fireworks NOT allowed.

**Note that Daytime Burning is NOT Allowed Between April 1 and October 31, No Matter What The Rating...**

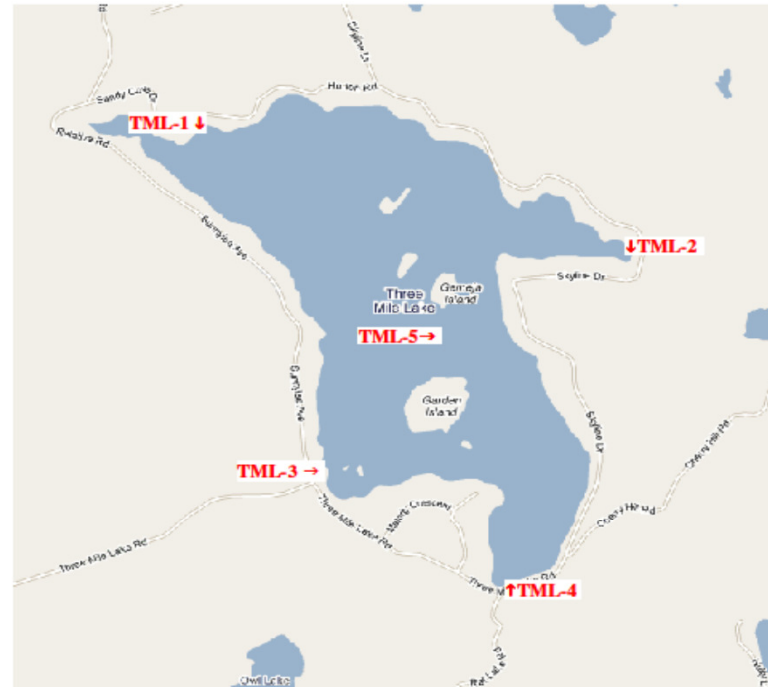
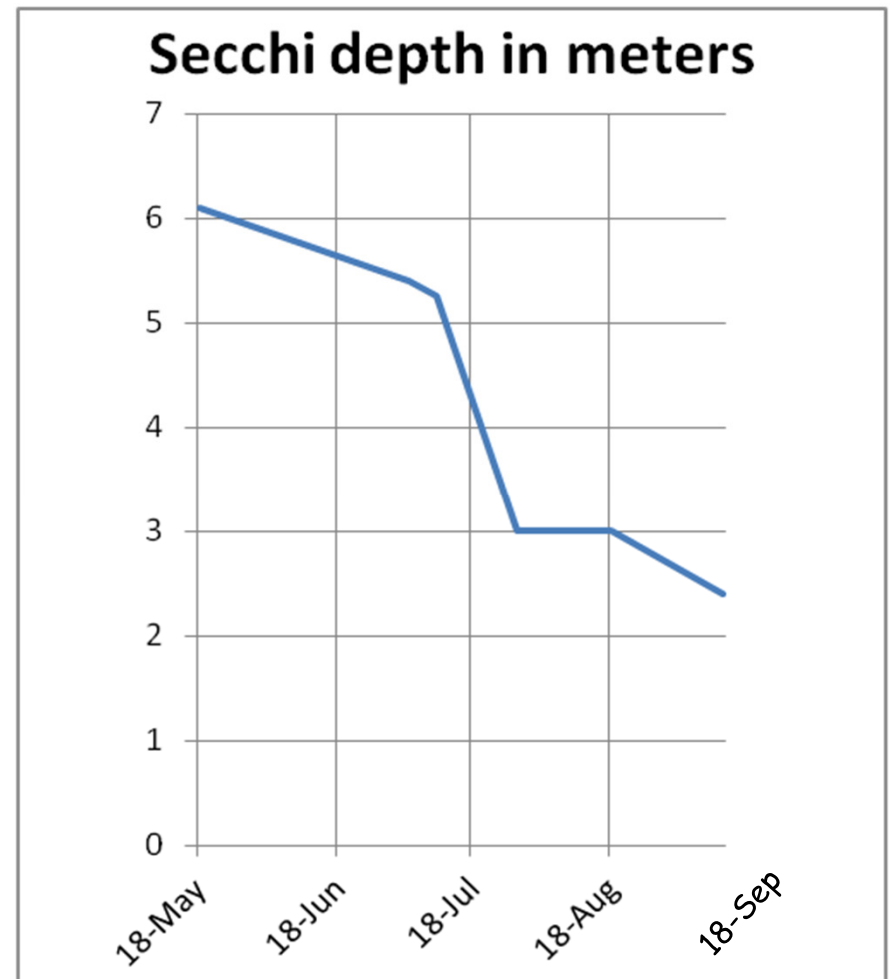
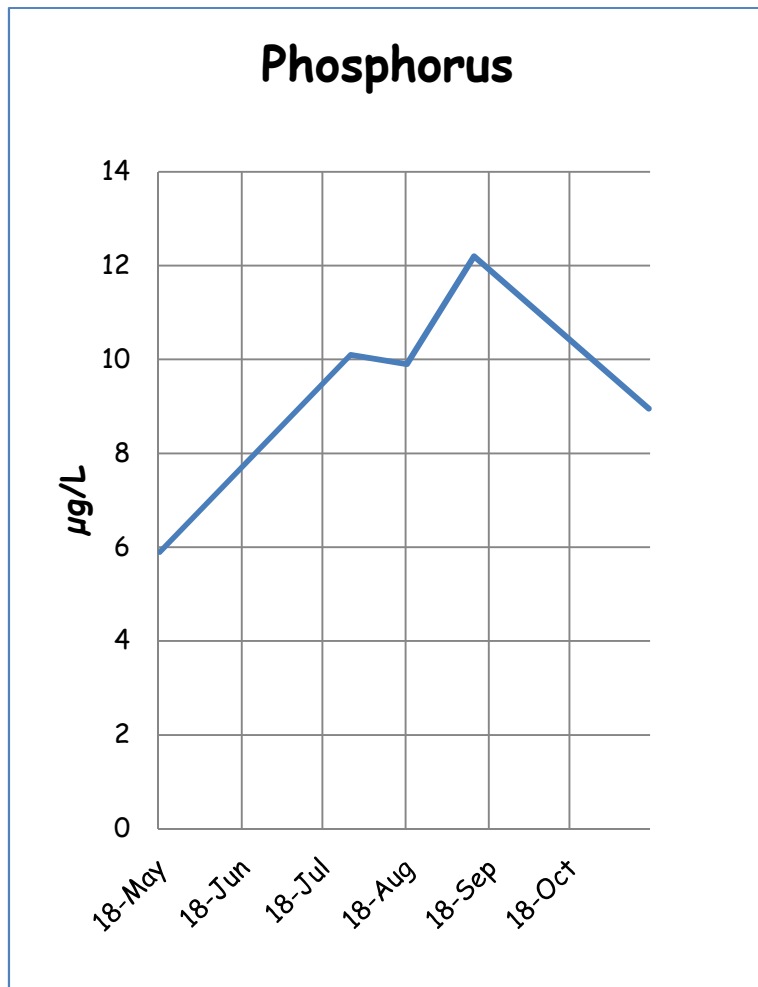


Figure 1. Three Mile Lake-Katrine Test Sites


# Summary Notes

- E.coli and coliform levels were below the Ontario recreational water use thresholds of 100cfus for *E.Coli* and 1000 cfus for coliform
- Measured phosphorus levels as determined by the Lake Partner Program and the U of Waterloo testing program were all below 12 ug/L
- Dissolved oxygen is important for the abundance and health of aquatic life (e.g. fish)...TML values ranged between 8.3 and 9.1 mg/L which are good levels for sustaining fish populations
- A healthy lake pH range is typically 6.5 - 8.5...TML range was 6.6 to 6.8. Great for swimming!
- Water clarity as measured with a Secchi disk started at 6.1 m in May and decreased to 2.4m in September, typical of previous years

Cottage Recipe...

## Yummy S'mores



### What you need:

- 4 HONEY MAID Honey Grahams, broken in half (8 squares)
- 4 JET-PUFFED Marshmallows, toasted
- 1 HERSHEY'S® Milk Chocolate Bar (1.55 oz.), quartered

### **Make It**

Sandwich 1 marshmallow and 1 chocolate piece between each of 2 graham wafers to make each s'more; press together gently to secure.

### **SPECIAL EXTRA**

Spread 1 tsp. Kraft Smooth Peanut Butter onto 1 wafer before using to prepare each s'more as directed.

**To make indoor s'mores**, do not toast the marshmallows. Place 4 graham squares on microwaveable plate; top with chocolate and marshmallows. Microwave on HIGH 15 to 20 sec. or until marshmallows puff. Cover with remaining graham squares; press together gently to secure.

Craft Corner...

*How to make a birch bark basket*

### What you need:

- birch bark
- cardboard or card stock
- craft glue



### What you do:

- Find a small box and trace each side onto birch bark.
- Cut out the traced pieces .
- Glue each piece onto the box.
- Use clothes pins to hold pieces in place until they dry.
- Finish by cutting a long strip of bark for a handle.



Use your birch bark basket to collect rocks, pinecones, acorns, berries, etc.!



# CASTING PRINTS

Animal prints are easy to find in summer and winter. Look closely in muddy woods or along lake and river edges to find tracks. Save your findings by making a plaster cast.



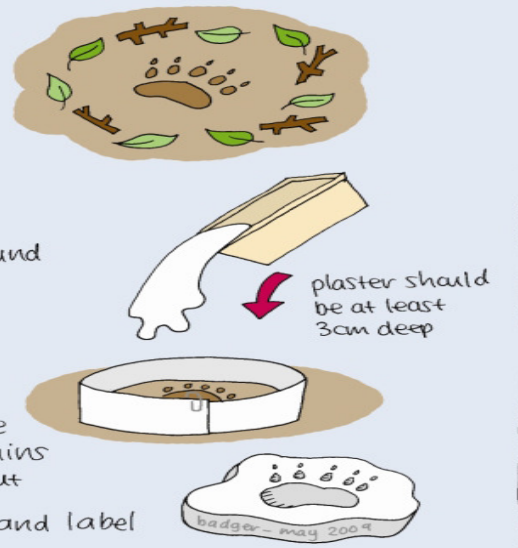
## How to go plaster casting



### What you need:

- plaster of paris (from a pharmacy)
- an old 500g margarine tub for mixing it in
- a stick or spoon for stirring
- water
- Strips of card, 10cm wide and long enough to fit around the footprint
- paperclips

- 1 Find a footprint and clear away any twigs and leaves from the area around it
- 2 Make a circle with the strip of card, join the ends with the paperclip, and push it into the ground around the footprint
- 3 Mix 5 tablespoons of dry plaster with water until it is like smooth cream
- 4 Pour the plaster into the card collar. Wait 5-10 mins for it to set then dig it out
- 5 Take home, wash, identify and label

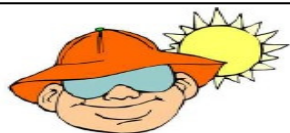
